TASTING NOTE

This wine smells of fresh cut cilantro and moist earth; currant bush, spicy oak and campfire smoke. Medium bodied with good acidity and drying tannins, stylistically it screams out "old world!"

80% Cabernet Sauvignon
11% Merlot
4% Malbec
3% Syrah
2% Cabernet Franc
